

## Expenses

For a visiting student at BBU in Cluj-Napoca, the *minimum* monthly living costs are about \$190:

Housing	\$50 – in the University dorms
Meals	\$100 – at the University cantina
Transport	\$10 – bus
Insurance	\$30 or US insurance

All students must register and pay tuition and all other fees at Wayne State University. They are also responsible for transportation to and from host institution, textbooks, clothing and personal expenses, WSU Health Insurance and SEVIS fees, passport and visa costs, and all other debts incurred during the exchange period.



*Qualifications for the program are that students must be junior or senior Computer Science majors with a minimum GPA of 3.0 to apply. Core or elective courses may be taken at Babes-Boylai University. Selected students need to complete an admissions application for Babes-Boylai University. Wayne State students at Babes-Boylai University shall be enrolled as regular students.*
